

## How to start SafePal Wallet

Now, I will explain how to use SafePal wallet from here.

First, install the SafePal wallet smartphone app.

This time, I will explain using an iPhone, but the basic steps are the same for Android, so please proceed according to the device you are using.

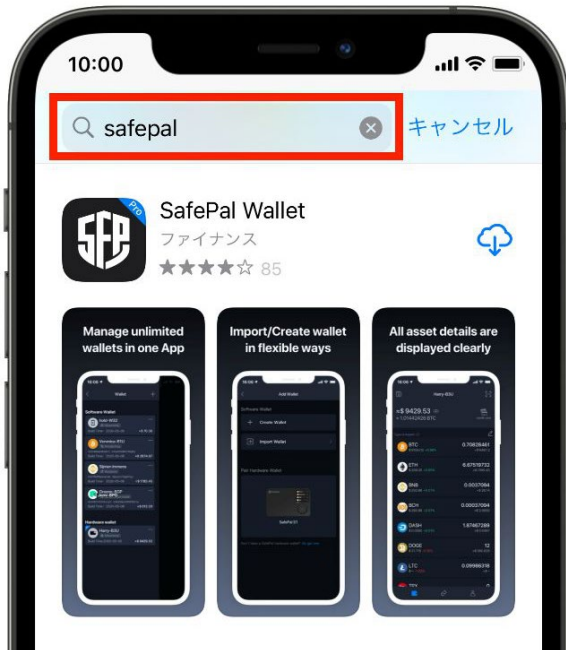
The procedure consists of the following three steps.

The procedure consists of the following three steps.

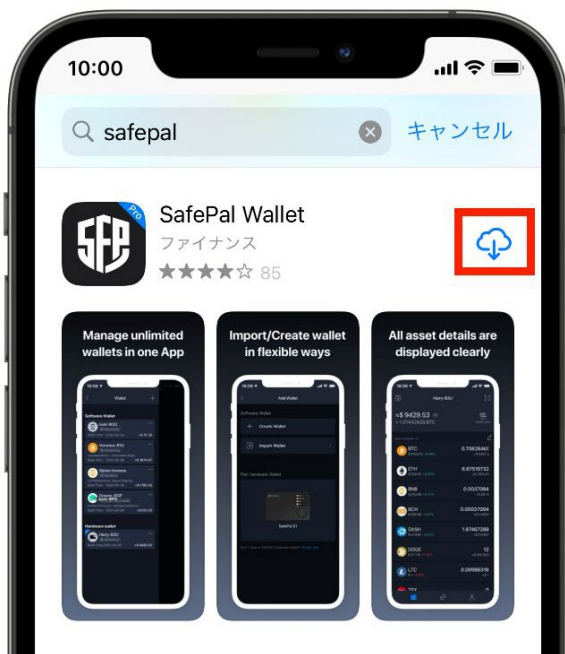
- 1 Install the app
- 2 Create a wallet
- 3 Mnemonic phrase backup

I will explain them in order.

## Step 1: Install the app



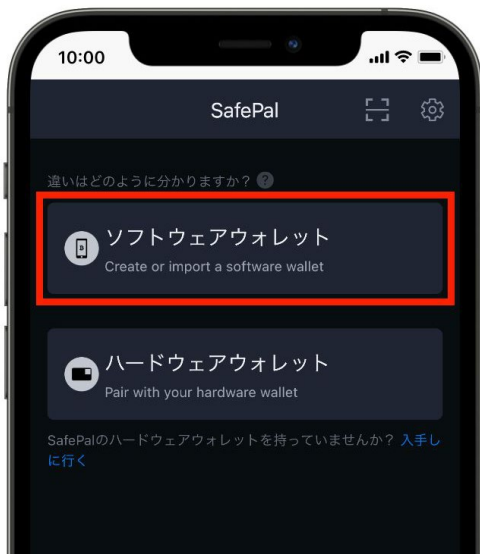
① Launch the App Store app and search for "**safepal**".



② Then the "**SafePal Wallet**" app will be hit, so tap "**Get**".

After a while, the app will complete downloading, and once the download is complete, open the app.

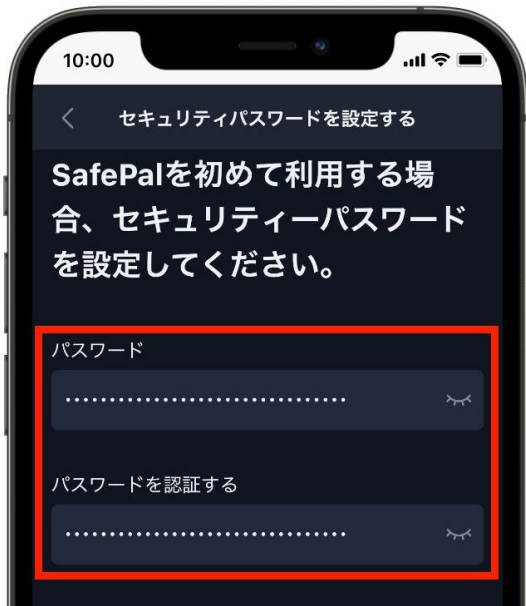
## Step 2 : Create a wallet



① You will then see a screen like this, so select **“Software Wallet”**.



② Tap **Next**.



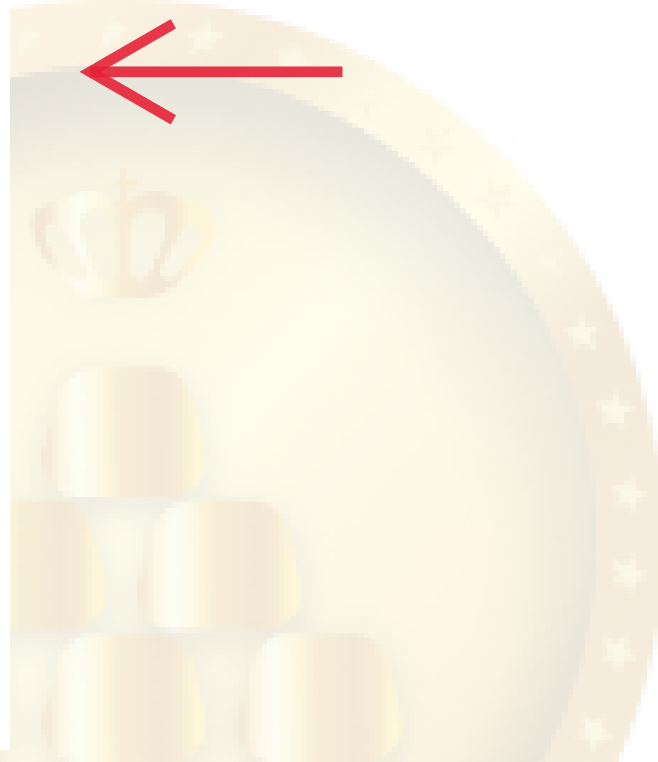
③ The password setting screen will appear, so enter your password.

 Note

Please be sure to never forget your password. This password is the password to open your SafePal wallet, and if you forget it, you will not be able to log in.



④ Once you have set your password, check Read the Terms of Use. If you check the box, you will be able to press "**Submit**" below, so tap it.



⑤ Next, the screen for setting the PIN code will appear. You can set this or not, but if you set this, you will not need to enter the password you set earlier when logging in. This time we will set the PIN code, but if you do not need it, please tap "**Skip**" at the top right.





⑥ To set the PIN code, trace the nine dots as you like.



⑦ Trace the nine dots again in the same order.



⑧ If you trace it twice, you will see a screen like the one above, so tap "**Start your SafePal journey**".



⑨ Then you will be returned to the screen shown above, so tap "**Software Wallet**" again.



⑩ Since this is your first time creating a wallet, tap "**Create wallet**" circled in red.





⑪ Enter the security password you decided on earlier. Once entered, tap "**Confirm**".



⑫ Next, enter your wallet name. You can choose any name you like for your wallet.



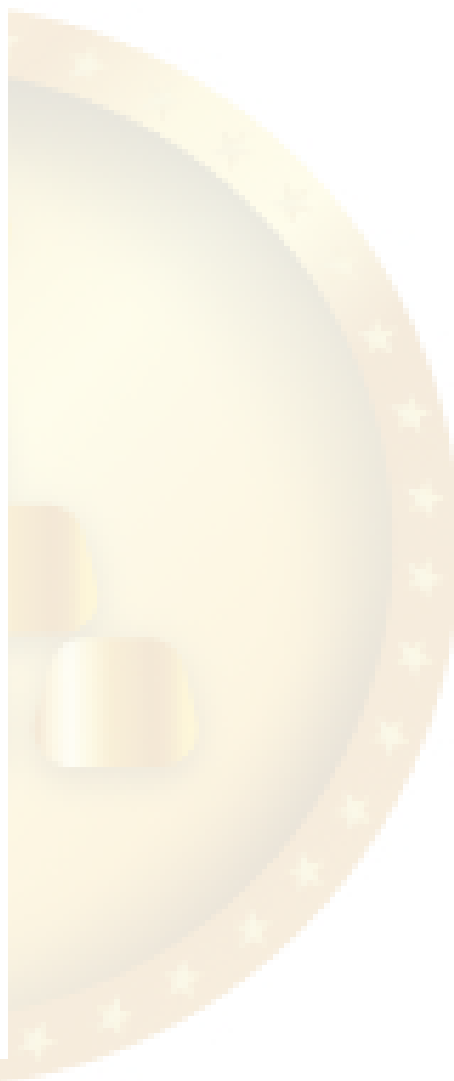
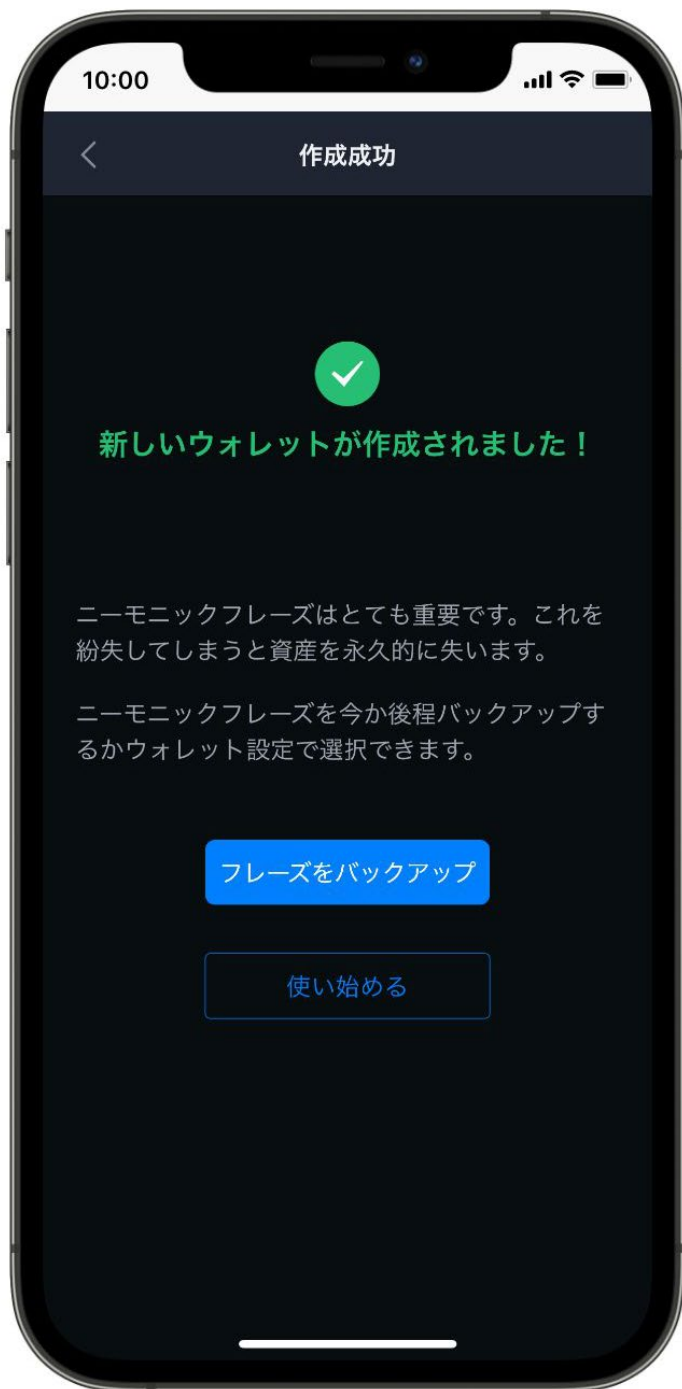
⑬ Next, regarding the mnemonic phrase below, a mnemonic phrase is something like a bank account pin number, and is made up of 12 or 24 English words. (In some cases, also called passphrase or seed phrase)

You can choose between 12 and 24 English words.

It doesn't matter which one you choose, but this time we will create a wallet with 12 items.

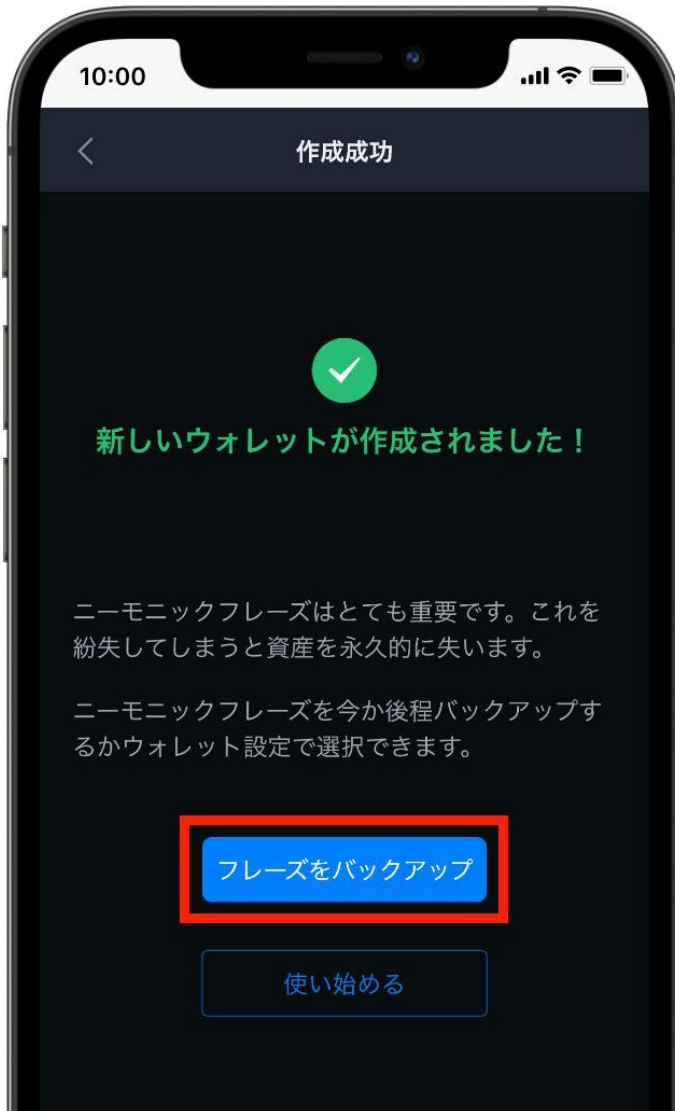


⑭ Tap **Done**.



⑮ If you see a screen like this, the wallet creation is complete.

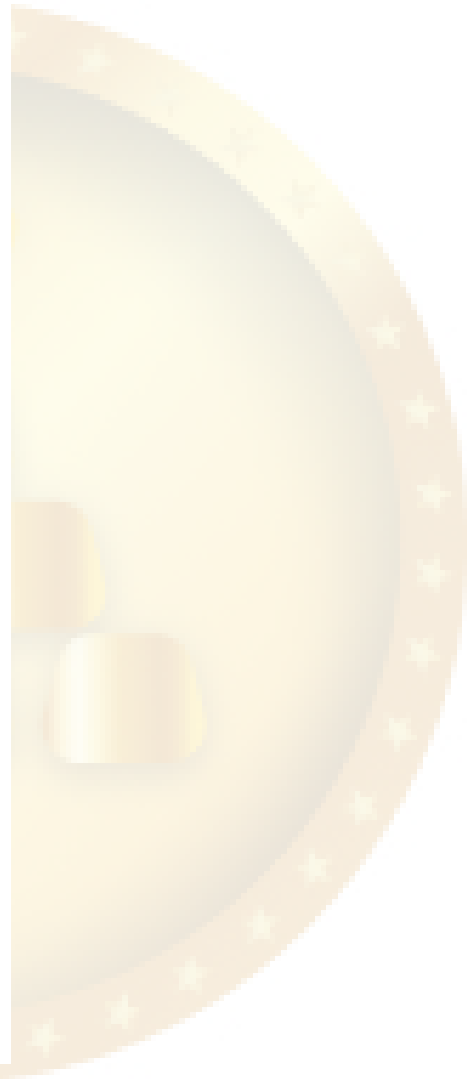
## Step 3 : Mnemonic phrase backup



- ① Next, make a backup of your mnemonic phrase.  
Tap **Back up phrases**.



② Then, a screen that says "**Important**" will appear, so read each item, check it, and tap "**I understand.**"



③ The mnemonic phrase will then be displayed.

The mnemonic phrase is important information that will be needed when restoring your wallet. Please store it carefully.

The storage method includes,

- ✓ Write on paper
- ✓ Take screenshots and save printouts
- ✓ Copy contents and manage them with your own password management software, etc.

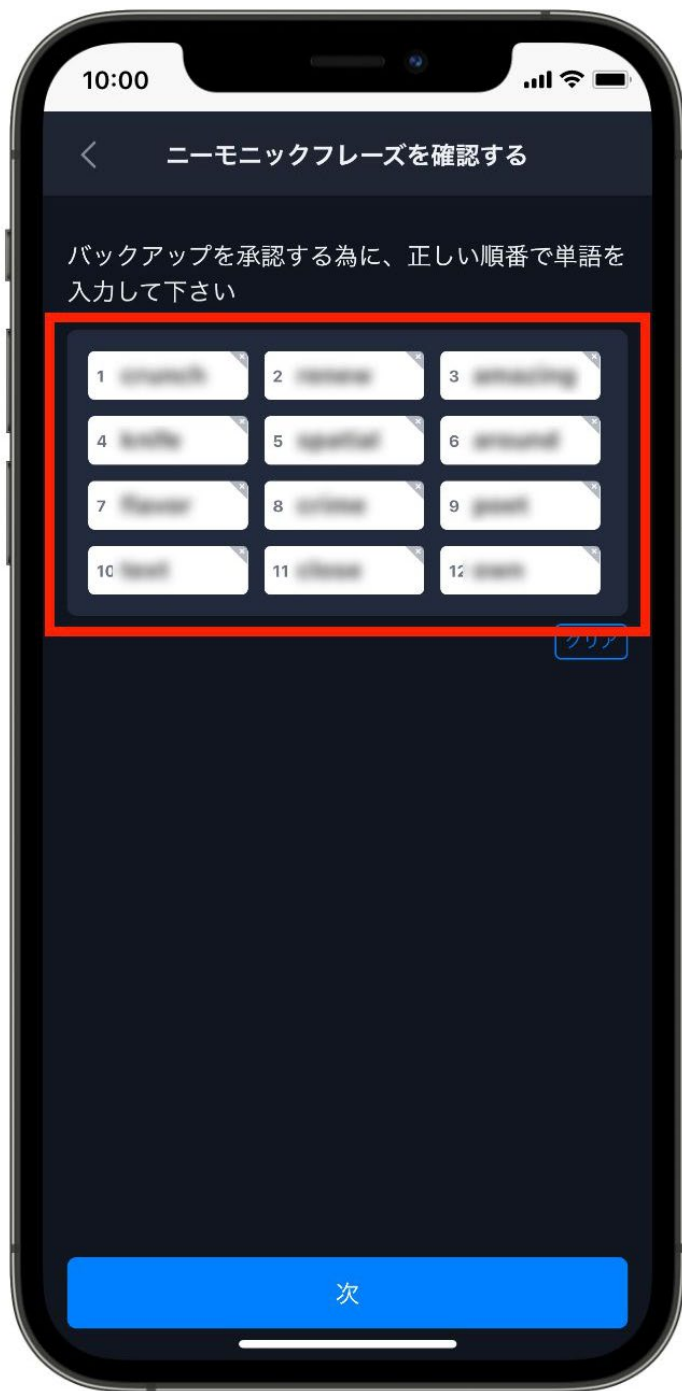
And so on. Please store it in a way that suits you.

### Note

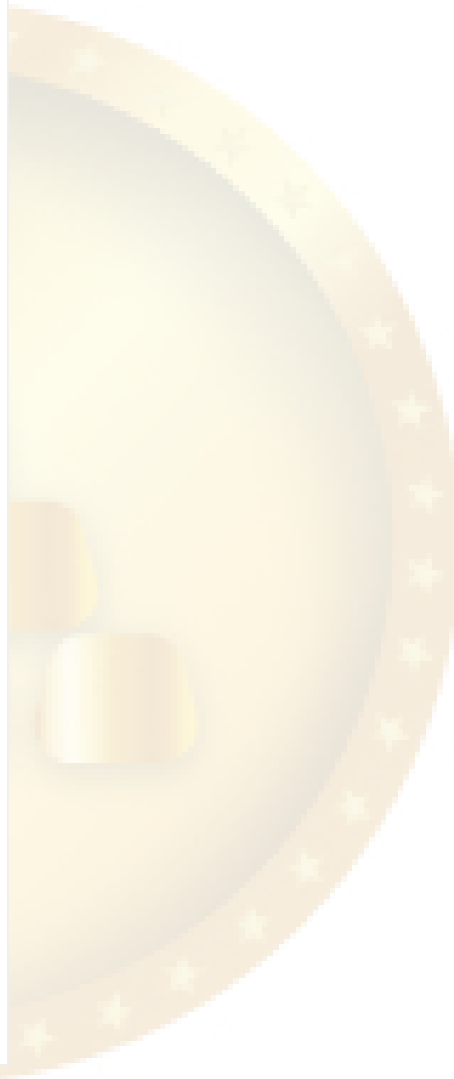
Please note that if someone knows your mnemonic phrase, they may be able to restore your wallet without permission and steal your assets, so be sure to save it so that no one else can see it.

Once saved, tap "**Next**".





④ Then, a screen like this will appear, so tap the mnemonic phrases you saved earlier to arrange them in order. When you have finished sorting, tap **"Next"**.



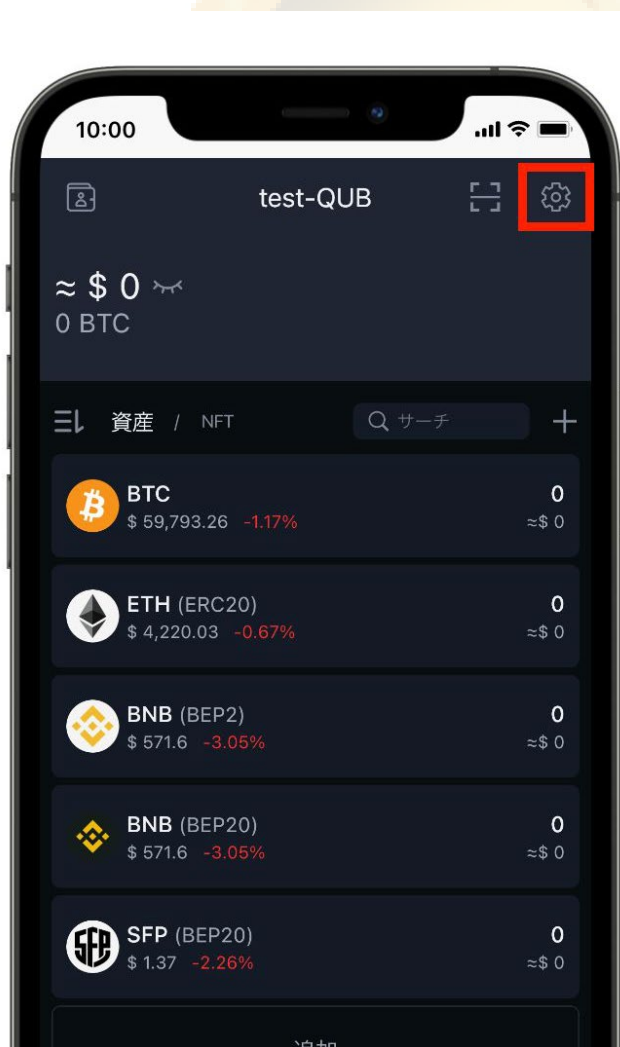
⑤ When you see a screen like this, the mnemonic phrase backup is complete. Thank you for your hard work m(\_ \_)m

## Initial settings of SafePal Wallet

Next, we will perform the initial settings of the SafePal wallet.

### Initial setting ①: Change currency from dollar to yen

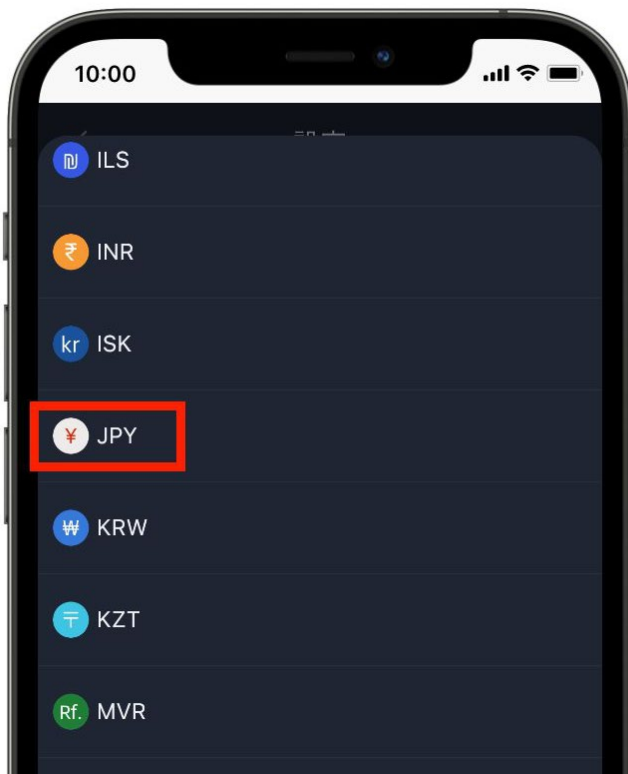
First of all, by default, the currency is expressed in dollars, so if you would like to display it in yen, you can change the setting by following the steps below.



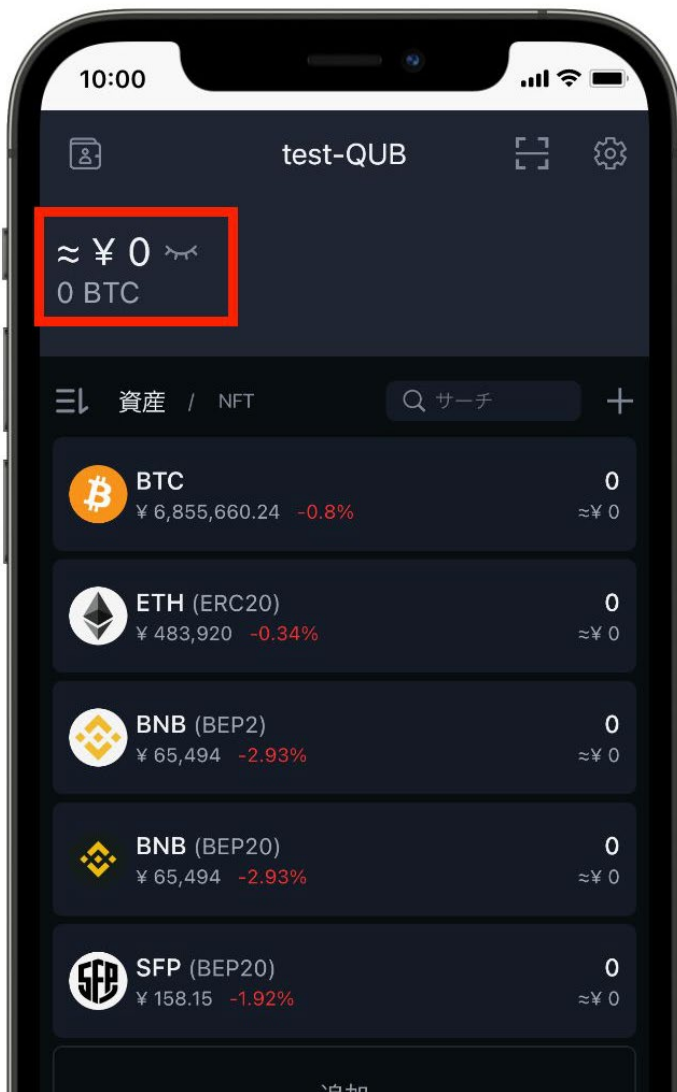
① Tap the gear icon at the top right of the screen.



② Tap the area that says "**USD**" surrounded by a red frame.



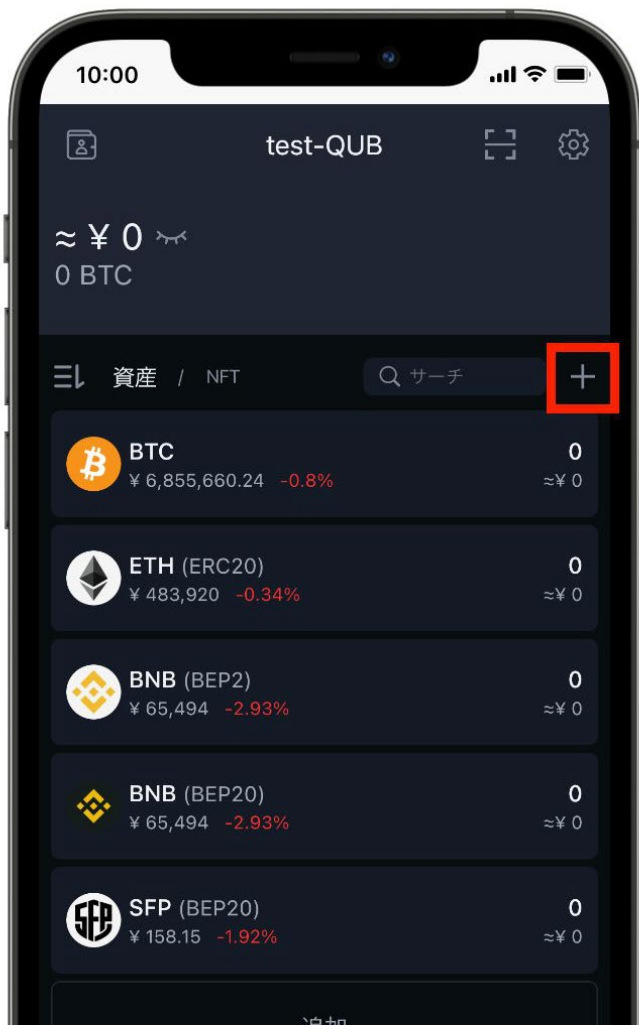
③ Search for and select "**JPY**" from the list.



④ When you return to the home screen, the display will have changed to a "¥" mark. The currency change is now complete.

## Initial settings ②: How to hide unnecessary tokens

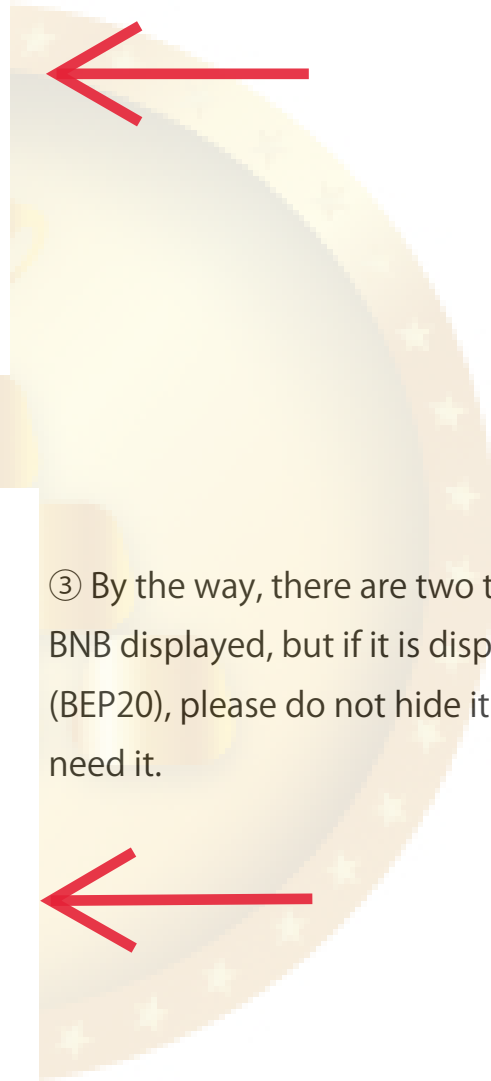
Next, we will hide unnecessary tokens displayed on the home screen.



① Tap the "+" button surrounded by a red frame.



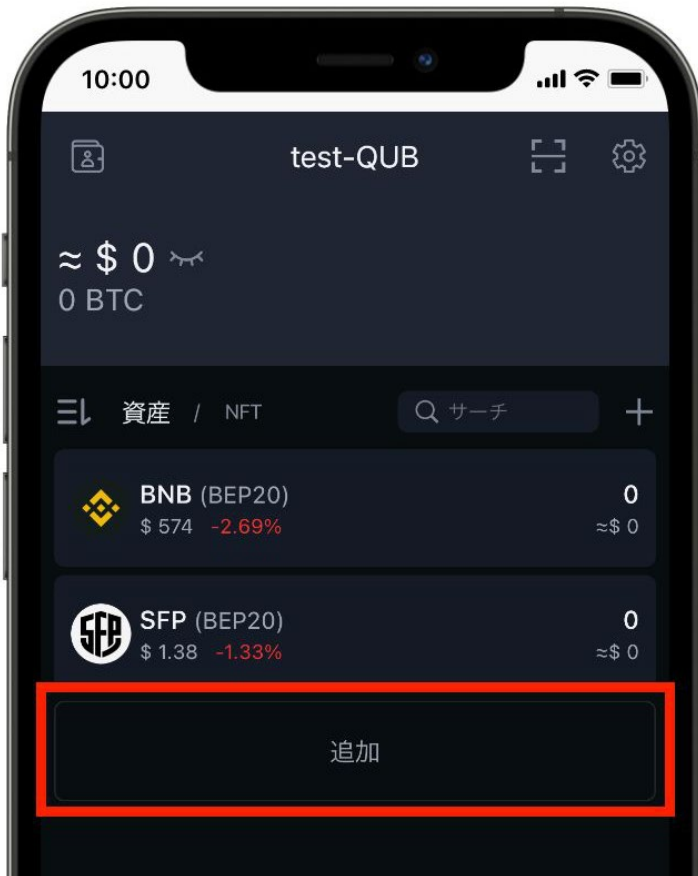
② This will bring up a screen like this, so uncheck the tokens you want to hide. This time, BTC, ETH, and BNB (BEP2) are not necessary for the explanation, so I will hide them.



③ By the way, there are two types of BNB displayed, but if it is displayed as (BEP20), please do not hide it as you will need it.

## Initial settings ③: How to add tokens

Finally, although this is not the initial setting, I would like to share how to add a token.



① First, open the home screen and tap "Add".



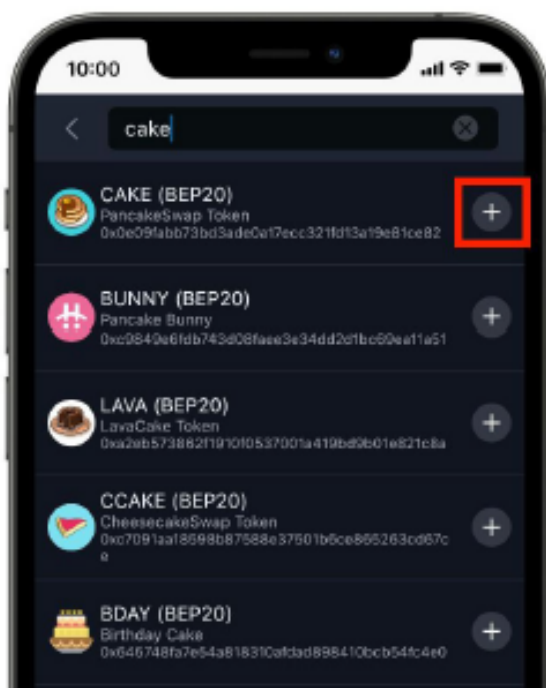


② Then a screen like this will appear, so enter the token name you want to add in the search window.



③ Here "**0xd29315Aa4B806EF6B97c075B00b235Ce20e9Cf7D**"

Let's enter: Then, "**GOLDMINING**" will be found in the search, so tap the "+" mark surrounded by the red frame.





④ When you return to the home screen, you will see that GMG has been added. The following article explains how to check the contract address of a token, so please refer to it if you like.
